Evaluation Process to measure Attainment of COs, PSOs and POs

Evaluation of Attainment of Course Outcomes (COs)

Overall attainment of the COs is evaluated by the respective department. The method of evaluation of the COs is as follows.

1. Overall attainment of COs is measured directly in terms of performance of students in semester end examination conducted by the university.

2. After the declaration of university examination results, every department prepares programme wise and course wise result analysis report.

3. As per the pre-defined benchmarks, departments evaluate overall attainment level for all COs for each course. For example;

a. if, for a given course, 50% of enrolled students have scored \geq 50 % marks in final examination then overall attainment level of COs is said to be LEVEL-1 (lowest level rated with weight 1).

b. if, for a given course, 60% of enrolled students have scored \geq 50 % marks in final examination then overall attainment level of COs is said to be LEVEL-2 (with weight 2)

c. if, for a given course, 70% of enrolled students have scored \geq 50 % marks in final examination then overall attainment level of COs is said to be LEVEL-3 (highest level with weight 3).

Evaluation of Attainment of Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs)

Overall attainment of PSOs of a given programme is evaluated on the basis of attainment of the respective PSOs at department level. The departments evaluate attainment of PSOs on the basis of "Level of Attainment" of all corresponding COs and the overall performance of students in class tests, seminars, quizzes, home assignments, project assignments, semester end common test and students' feedback on teaching, learning & evaluation.

Evaluation of Programme Outcomes (POs) Attainment

The POs are the qualities that a graduates must have acquired at the time of completion of their programme. Thus, at the end of each program, evaluation of attainment of POs is done from the COs and PSOs attainment of all subjects. Other key parameters considered for evaluation of attainment of POs are percentage of students due for degree, percentage of merits in university merit list, other achievements of the students and students' feedback.

Review on attainment of COs, PSOs and POs

Quantitative reports on overall attainment of COs and PSOs of all programmes are collected by IQAC so as to prepare attainment of corresponding Pos

Result analysis of semester end university examinations is discussed in Council of Heads, Staff Council and College Development Committee meetings. According to suggestions of authorities of the said committees IQAC initiated the action for further improvement


Attainment table for the Academic Session 2019-20






